# Buy Recycled

There are lots of opportunities to buy recycled products. Look at the labels when you shop. The PCC% on paper products indicates the amount of recycled content used when making the product, the higher the number the greater the amount of recycled material used.

When making purchases look for :

Carpeting or mats

Tools

Fencing, lumber or benches

Notebooks, envelopes, calendars, greeting cards, paper towels, bath tissue, etc with recycled content.

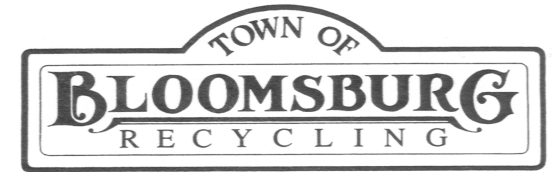

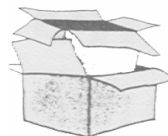

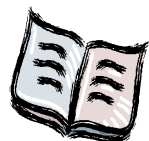

## ACCEPTABLE

All food and beverage glass jars and bottles. All jars and bottles must be empty and rinsed with lids removed.

Corrugated cardboard boxes and brown paper bags. Corrugated boxes have layer of ridges around edge.

Newspaper and the inserts go with news. Also place phone books with newspaper. Magazines and catalogs.

All beverage and food cans made of metal (aluminum & tin cans) including cookie tins. Includes soda bottles, milk jugs, Detergent bottles, shampoo, ketchup, etc. Empty, rinse and remove the lids.

Computer paper, copy paper, letterhead and writing paper, also envelopes without windows.

All components of a computer-keyboard, mouse, speakers, monitors, scanners, towers, printers, toner cartridges. Also accept VCRs, radios and cell phones.

## NOT ACCEPTABLE

Lids, caps or bottle tops. Window pane, light bulbs, ceramics, pottery, mirror glass, cups or plates or milk glass.

Wax cardboard, Korean cardboard, cereal, tissue or cookie boxes, gift boxes or soda cartons.

Papers must be dry.

Aerosol cans or paint cans, aluminum siding, scrap metal or frying pans, #3 -#7 containers such as cool whip tubs, butter or cottage cheese tubs, motor oil or anti-freeze bottles, styrofoam or plastic bags.

Junk mail, tissue or carbon paper, envelopes with windows, ream wrappers.

Televisions, copiers, microwaves or appliances.
