Chairperson Justin Hummel called the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m., present were Council members Bonnie Crawford, James Garman, and Vince DeMelfi, Town Manager/Secretary/Treasurer Lisa Dooley, Chief of Police Scott Price, and Law Enforcement Administrative Assistant Randi Fetterman.

On a motion by B. Crawford, seconded by V. DeMelfi, and voted on unanimously, the Committee approved the 11/15/2022 meeting minutes with no corrections.

Discussion took place regarding increasing parking fees. Fees have not been adjusted in the lots in over 50 years. Eventually the meters will need to be replaced. L. Dooley suggested researching parking enforcement in other local areas for parking costs. J. Hummel doesn't believe the college students are utilizing as many spaces as they once did.

B. Crawford discussed that the fee for individuals receiving boots in private lots is extravagant. It is on private property and the Town cannot enforce or set pricing.

B. Crawford discussed potentially making 6th Street a one-way street.
