

A Special meeting of Bloomsburg Town Council was held Monday, May 19, 2014, beginning at 8:31 a.m. in Council Chambers, Town Hall, 301 East Second Street, Bloomsburg, PA. Present were Mayor Sandy Davis; Council Members W. Carey Howell, Bill Kreisher, Fred Trump and Eric Bower; Town Administrator William Lowthert; Assistant Town Administrator Lauren Martz; Director of Finance Lisa Laboskie and Fire Chief Bob Rupp. Absent were Council Members Diane Levan and Sylvia Costa.

ADOPTION OF ORDINANCE NO. 955 – INCREASING THE INDEBTEDNESS OF THE TOWN OF BLOOMSBURG FOR THE PURCHASE OF A FIRE ENGINE

On a motion by C. Howell, seconded by E. Bower and voted on unanimously, Council adopted Ordinance No. 955 increasing the indebtedness of the Town of Bloomsburg, Columbia County, Pennsylvania, by the Issue of a General Obligation Note in the amount of \$350,000.00 for sundry purpose; fixing the form, number, date, interest, and maturity thereof; making a covenant for the payment of the debt service on the note; providing for the filing of the required document; providing for the appointment of a sinking fund depository for the note; and authorizing execution, sale and delivery thereof.

B. Kreisher inquired about how the obligation to this note will be paid back. W. Lowthert explained that the Fire Tax Fund will be used to pay for the note obligations. The Town should have sufficient funds within the Fire Tax Fund to cover the monthly payment.

B. Rupp explained that the apparatus will be available the first or second week of June. B. Kreisher inquired if the apparatus had a warranty and B. Rupp responded that there are multiple warranties for different parts of the apparatus.

Being no further business, the meeting adjourned at 8:36 a.m.
