A special meeting of Bloomsburg Town Council was held Friday, December 28, 2018, beginning at 3:15 p.m. in Council Chambers, Town Hall, 301 East Second Street, Bloomsburg, PA. Present were Mayor William Kreisher; Vice President Toni Bell; Council Members Fred Trump, James Garman, Bonnie Crawford, and Vince DeMelfi; Town Manager/Secretary Lauren Martz; Director of Human Resources/Assistant Secretary Tracy Lanzafame; Administrative Assistant Bobbi Erlston; and Airport Coordinator BJ Teichman. Absent was Council Member James Huber.

## **CITIZENS TO BE HEARD**

Steve Coladonato noted that he sent letters to Council Members with suggestions on how to cut expenses in the proposed budget. The suggestions are listed below:

- 1. Employees contribute more funds towards their health care coverage.
- 2. The Pension Plans can be converted into 401K plans for new hires.
- 3. Non-student housing that has been converted into student housing should be assessed as student housing to correct the taxes.
- 4. Limit funds that are being spent on the Bloomsburg Municipal Airport.

W. Kreisher noted that there might be a few areas in which the Town can increase revenue from parking including places at the university that currently aren't being charged a fee that can be added to the General Fund.

Being no further business Council adjourned into executive Session at 3:38 p.m. and did not reconvene.
