MJ Mahon and representatives from RTI: Dave Schaar, Dominick Tureaud, and a public citizen.

RTI provided an update on the firewalls. The firewalls have been implemented and rules created for communication between sites. RTI highly recommends double authentication to connect to resources. VPN connection was discussed that within the next few weeks that RTI will be installing the VPN connection on the machines. RTI has the police camera server in inventory and they just need to schedule an install within the next two weeks. The Town Hall and police servers were shipped out to the site locations and RTI will be working on server migration. E-mail phishing service is up and running. The e-mail encryption will be installed by this Friday. The website was discussed that the domain name is the same as the computer name and the work around is to typing out the entire website address. The web developer needs to create a redirect and move into a www. folder and rebuild the domain and migrate to something else.

On a motion by N. McGaw, seconded by J. Kressler, and voted on unanimously, the Committee approved the \$36 a month invoice for double authentication.

The website slowness was discussed and also the function of paying recycling bills online.
