ADJOURNMENT



The Regular Meeting of the Bloomsburg Municipal Authority Board was held on Tuesday, December 10, 2024, beginning at 4:00pm in the Conference Room of the Municipal Authority Office, 1000 Market Street, Suite 9, Bloomsburg, PA.

Chair Thomas Evans presided. Those present included Treasurer Michael Upton; Board Members Sylvia Costa, Bill Brobst and Nick McGaw; Assistant Plant Superintendent Mark Tappe; Maintenance/Collection System Supervisor Josh Young; Special Projects Coordinator Ryan Longenberger; Jeff Slabinski and George Myers, Myers Environmental Services; Solicitor Alvin Luschas, Luschas, Naparsteck & Crane LLP; Steven Siegfried, P.E., Rettew; Secretary/Office Manager Amber Kenney and Billing and Collections Director Amy Seamans. Also in attendance were Mary Ward and MJ Mahon.

CITIZEN TO BE HEARD - MIKE BARRATT

Mike Barratt was present. He asked the Board why they only approved paying 50% of his monthly health insurance premium. T. Evans explained that the union contract states the employee is responsible for 100% of the cost of the premium until attainment of age 62 and the board agreed, as a gesture, they would cover 50% of the cost after the weekly required contribution is deducted. Mike explained that he gave 35 years to the Authority and has always gotten along with everyone and was hurt when he learned that the cost would not be completely covered by the Authority. He said he's retiring under disability because he has a bad heart and his doctor told him he shouldn't be working. He would like to see all of the premium paid for by the Authority. He femarked that now he will be starting off his retirement "in the hole".

On a motion by M. Upton, seconded by B. Brobst and voted on unanimously, the Board approved the November 12, 2024 meeting minutes without any additions or corrections.

APPROVAL OF PAYMENT OF MONTHLY OPERATING AND MAINTENANCE BILLS FOR NOVEMBER

On a motion by B. Brobst, seconded by S. Costa and voted on unanimously, the Board approved payment of the monthly operating and maintenance bills for November in the amount of \$230,879.61.

APPROVAL OF PAYMENT OF MONTHLY SEWER MAINTENANCE BILLS FOR NOVEMBER

On a motion by B. Brobst, seconded by N. McCaw and voted on unanimously, the Board approved payment of the monthly sewer maintenance bills for November in the amount of 73,343.56.

APPROVAL OF PAYMENT TO KORN FERRY FROM THE MUNICIPAL AUTHORITY EMPLOYEE PENSION FUND

On a motion by S. Costa, seconded by M. Upton and voted on unanimously, the Board approved payment to Korn Ferry in the amount of \$4,285.00 from the Municipal Authority Employee Pension Fund for 4th quarter actuarial services.

APPROVAL OF CHANGE ORDER NO. 1 FROM DON E. BOWER, INC. FOR THE ROSE AVENUE SEWER REHABILITATION PROJECT

On a motion by N. McGaw, seconded by S. Costa and voted on unanimously, the Board approved change order No. 1 from Don E. Bower, Inc. in the decreased amount of \$21,466.52 for the Rose Avenue Sewer Rehabilitation Project.

APPROVAL OF FINAL PAYMENT NO. 2 TO DON E. BOWER, INC. FOR THE ROSE AVENUE SEWER REHABILITATION PROJECT

On a motion by M. Upton, seconded by B. Brobst and voted on unanimously, the Board approved final payment No. 2 to Don E. Bower, Inc. in the amount of \$8,066.84 for the Rose Avenue Sewer Rehabilitation Project.

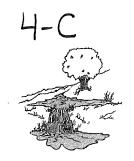

Operations Report 01/14/2025

- The monthly average effluent flow at the WWTP for December 2024 was **1.3992 MGD** and total precipitation for the month was **1.79**". For comparison the average effluent flow for December 2023 was **2.5167 MGD** and rainfall was **4.78**".
- The week of 12/23/2024 we started receiving "**High Motor Winding Temperature**" alarms on Internal Mixed Liquor Pump #2. This pump was taken out of service for removal and troubleshooting.
- There was a meeting held on December 16, 2024 @ 10:00am at the MATB office. The meeting
 was with representatives from Verdantas, Columbia County, the Town of Bloomsburg, and the
 Bloomsburg High School. The purpose of this meeting was to discuss the Floodwall Study and
 possible design options.
- Plan staff removed Internal Mixed Liquor Pump #2 on 01/6/2025. The pump was picked up by OPSCO on 01/8/2025 for repair.
- On 01/6/2025 plant staff discovered that the PLC touch screen was no longer working for the
 Fournier rotary sludge press. Martz Technologies was contacted to resolve the issue. Upon
 inspection it was concluded that the PLC screen completely burnt out and is considered
 obsolete. A new and up to date configuration will need to replace it. The cost and configuration
 of the new PLC screen will be \$ 14,546.21.

 Plant staff ordered a new 8.7HP Flygt Dry Pit submersible pump for the Mary Avenue Pump Station through Orchard Pump & Supply Company (OPSCO) via Costars. The total price is \$28,193.00.
