On a motion by J. Kressler, seconded by J. Jordan, and voted on unanimously, the Committee approved the minutes from the April 16, 2025 meeting.

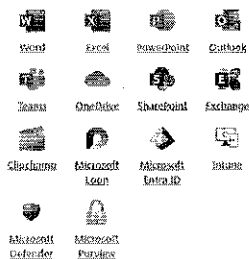

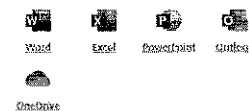

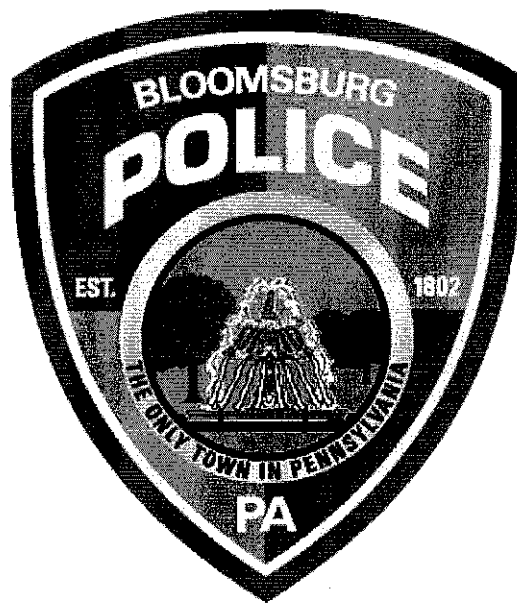
