

Curbside Reminders:

Recycling - It's the Law! Recycling is mandatory in Bloomsburg. The Town provides ALL residential curbside collection per ordinance #862. It is unlawful for anyone else to collect residential recycling within the Town.



AREA 2

Both sides of Market Street from Main Street to 5th Street. Includes the west side north of the fountain. Collection includes all streets and alleys up to but DOES NOT include 5th Street.

AREA 3

Both sides of 5th Street west of Market Street. Includes both sides of Market Street from 5th Street to Fort McClure Blvd.

AREA 1

Collection includes both sides of Lightstreet Road. Both sides of Main Street to the Fountain Square. Includes the east side north of the Fountain.

AREA 4

South of Lightstreet Road, includes all rear Main Street to Market Street. Ends north of 7th Street. DOES NOT include any of 7th Street. East of Market Street. DOES NOT include any of Market Street.

AREA 5

All area south of 7th Street, includes both sides of 7th Street, east of Market Street, DOES NOT include any of Market Street.



America's 250th Anniversary: Reflecting on a Quarter Millennium of Freedom and Progress

On July 4, 2026, the United States of America will celebrate its 250th anniversary—a historic milestone marking two and a half centuries since the signing of the Declaration of Independence in 1776. This occasion, known as the *Semiquincentennial*, invites Americans to reflect on the country's remarkable journey from a fledgling group of colonies to a global leader and a diverse, dynamic democracy.

Did you know—Pennsylvania became the second state on December 12, 1787.

Bloomsburg University was founded in 1839, as the Bloomsburg Literary Institute. The first building was Carver Hall.

The Rupert Covered Bridge No. 56 is on the National Register of Historic Places and is the oldest existing covered bridge in Columbia County. Constructed in 1847.



The Town of Bloomsburg, Pennsylvania, was established on March 4, 1870. It was incorporated as a town, making it the only incorporated town in the state. The area was originally laid out in 1802 by Ludwig Eyer and was known as Eyersburg and Eyertown. In 1870, it merged with Bloom Township and became the town of Bloomsburg. @

CLEAR GLASS: All bottles & jars must be emptied & rinsed, and all caps & lids removed. NO window panes, light bulbs, mirrors or ceramics. KEEP SEPARATE FROM COLORED GLASS



COLORED GLASS: Includes brown, green & blue bottles & jars must be emptied, with caps & lids removed. KEEP SEPARATE FROM CLEAR GLASS



METAL CANS: Includes both steel & aluminum cans in one bin. All cans must be emptied & rinsed. NO foil, pans or aerosol cans.



PLASTIC: #1 & #2 plastic bottles (soda, milk, detergent bottles). Empty & rinse, discard caps & lids, flatten. NO plastic bags, ice cream buckets, yogurt cups, motor oil bottles or butter tubs.



NEWSPRINT: newspapers, bundle or bag (paper bags only). NO magazines, junk mail or phone books.

& PASTEBOARD BOXES: includes cereal,
tissue, pasta & shoeboxes. Also includes phone
books. KEEP SEPARATE FROM NEWSPAPER,
