The meeting started at 6 p.m. via Zoom. Present were John Grabusky, Joan Mosier, Tara Moore, and Nichole Harman (up until 6:32 p.m.). Lisa Dooley, Town Manager/ Secretary/ Treasurer was also present along with Will Ralston at 6:40 p.m.

On a motion by T. Moore, seconded by J. Mosier, and voted on unanimously, the Commission approved the May 1, 2025 meeting minutes.

The vacancy was discussed. It was announced that two people already have reached out with interest.

The signs for the Town Park were discussed and having the final text sent to Town Council for review. The following was decided upon.

Will Ralston was present and said he is a part of the Family Resource Network of Bloomsburg and identifying issues of bullying and working with the school and placing up different language signs. It was mentioned that the school district doesn't have a translator.
